### **Gardner Ten Pins \$100 Sport Challenge Award**

This season-ending award will be given to the bowler who finishes the 2008-09 season with best overall individual average.

1. Bowlers must bowl at least two-thirds of the season.
2. Bowlers must complete a minimum of nine games on each of the following patterns: Shark, Cheetah, Viper, Chameleon and Scorpion.
3. Bowlers must be full-time members of the league (subs not eligible).
4. Bowlers must not owe any money at the end of the season.
5. Any questions or disputes regarding rules and eligibility requirements will be resolved by the award sponsor.

### **Factorxbowling.com \$100 Match Point Challenge Tournament**

This tournament is by invitation only and will take place following the final night of bowling on May 7, 2009.

Bowlers earn an invitation to this event by finishing one of the three 11-week PBA Experience Trios rounds with the best individual match point record (based on the percentage of wins versus losses). Multiple bowlers can earn exemptions in a single round, should the round end in a tie.

Following the last night of bowling, all bowlers earning an entry into the tournament will bowl one game. The bowler's handicap will then be added to their score, and the bowler with the highest handicap pinfall will be declared champion. In the event one or more bowlers tie with the same score, those bowler(s) will have a two-frame roll-off to break the tie, with each bowler receiving one-fifth of their normal handicap.

Rules and eligibility requirements are as follows:

1. Bowlers must bowl at least two-thirds of the round in which they qualify.
2. Bowlers must complete a minimum of nine games on each of the following patterns: Shark, Cheetah, Viper, Chameleon and Scorpion.
3. Bowlers must be full-time members of the league in the round in which they qualified. Qualifying bowlers must remain members of the league through the end of the season. Bowlers who qualified as members of the league who later withdrew before season's end must petition the league's Board of Directors for permission to compete in the tournament.
4. Any bowler who qualifies for the tournament but does not bowl at least two-thirds of the games in any given 11-week round will be penalized 5 pins off their tournament score for each round in which they failed to bowl the minimum number of games for that round.
5. Bowlers may qualify for this tournament only once.
6. Bowlers must not owe any money at the end of the season or they forfeit their right to bowl in the tournament.
7. Any questions or disputes regarding rules and eligibility requirements will be resolved by the award sponsor.
